The Mariner firefighting suit is a lightweight two piece garment consisting of a jacket and trousers manufactured from canvas cotton material treated and tested to meet the requirements of:

The mariner suit is comfortable and durable, suitable for short or long term wearing, regular or intermittent application in firefighting.

The three-quarter length jacket is secured by a press stud inner fly and an external protective overfly fastened by touch and close fabric plus a drawcord hem. The style incorporates two patch pockets with drainage facility, a deep lined collar throat flap and inner adjustable anti debris cuffs. A water repellent interlining is incorporated with an inner cotton comfort lining.

The trousers are braces supported and lined with vapour and water repellent fabric. The legs are double thickness fabric to the knee and have an additional permeation barrier interlayered.

Helmets with flip up visor neck curtain and chin straps, gloves and boots are also available. Complete sets can be supplied in storage boxes or carrying valises as required.



The Mariner firefighting suit is also available in aluminised rayon, this version is also M.E.D. approved. Please ask for data sheet if this style is required.
